FIRST RESPONDER COURSE – CERTIFICATE ONLY

Preferred option for those just requiring a certificate for school, sports medicine, and volunteer response.

40 hours of teaching

***No Scope Updates, No EMALB** (Emergency Medical Assistants Licensing Board) practical exams, no WorkSafeBC Equivalencies.

3-year Canadian Red Cross First Responder Certificate

No EMALB exam preparation included

* can update scope and exams at a later date (within 11 months of certification for additional fees)

COURSE W/ EMALB EXAMS AND SCOPE UPDATES (56 HOURS)

For those going into a Professional Responder role, such as Firefighting or Event Medic, which requires licensing.

Additionally, for WorkSafeBC Intermediate First Aid with Transportation Endorsement equivalent (once complete EMALB)

Canadian Red Cross First Responder Certificate is issued upon completion.

Additional hours for EMALB exams, eligible for EMALB First Responder License.
